During these unprecedented and uncertain times when people are being urged to stay home, I wanted to write to you to make you aware of the services that we have to offer your ratepayers from the comfort of their homes.

Joining the library is free for all and can be done online via our website www.douglaslibrary.im. There is an online form to fill out and attach proof of address to and then users will automatically be sent a reader number and PIN to allow them instant access to our 24/7 free online services which include:

- Thousands of eBooks and eAudiobooks available via our website or the Libby app. This includes titles for adults and children.
- An eMagazine service which gives access to over 60 magazines; titles include BBC Good Food, Closer, Men’s and Women’s Health, Cosmopolitan, Top Gear and PlayStation and Xbox. They can be downloaded onto a mobile device and accessed anywhere via the RBdigital app
- Also available through the RBdigital app is access to thousands of eAudiobooks.
- Access a wide range of authoritative reference materials, e.g. Encyclopaedia Britannica and Oxford Reference Online, which are fantastic resources for homework and research.
