The minutes of Lezayre Parish Commissioners meeting held on Thursday 8th September 2011, at 7.00pm, The Community Hall, Clenagh Road, Sulby, Lezayre.

Members present: Mr C W Roberts (Chairman), Mrs. V A Quane (Vice Chairman), Mr. A D Radcliffe and Mr K Brew. Mr Brew arrived a few minutes late, and had already advised the clerk. Mrs. M Rimmer the Clerk took the minutes. No members of the public attended. No members of the press were in attendance.

Matters arising from the minutes

Mr Radcliffe expressed his sympathy to Mrs Quane for the sad loss of her sister. Similar messages of condolence were also offered by the other members.

The clerk advised the members regarding the progress for chasing up the cutting of the hedge on Crossags Lane. Anna Goldsmith had written to the various landowners giving notice for the hedges to be cut back. Mrs Quane advised that Mr Corkill has cut his hedge on the Crossags Lane. A letter written to the Chief Minister of the DOI regarding hedge cutting was acknowledged and should be responded to shortly. Mrs Quane advised that Mr Gawne had now agreed for hedges to be cut by his department.

The clerk advised that the information regarding bins at Quarry Bends, Black Hut and at the 23rd Milestone would be available. This information is needed for the Commissioners to decide whether it is necessary for them to take them over when the DOI pass over the responsibility for them.

The clerk advised that the Isle of Man Water Authority are happy to arrange a visit to the Ramsey Service Reservoir when the Commissioners have ideas of dates.

Mrs Quane asked if a reply had been received with regard to the opening of Lezayre Church for Remembrance Sunday. Rev Evans-Smith had sent an email advising that the Commissioners would be invited to attend the service held at St Stephens Church, and a service at the War Memorial would follow at 11am. The Commissioners discussed this suggestion but felt that as in previous years they would like the service to be held at the War Memorial, followed by a Church Service. Mr Radcliffe proposed and Mrs Quane seconded that the clerk write to Helen Rowlands requesting that a Remembrance Service is held at the War Memorial followed by a service in the Lezayre Church on Sunday 13th November 2011

The clerk had requested information with regard to the "Dog Fouling" signs required for the parish. The clerk advised a price of £6.00 each. The clerk was asked to look further for signs and to obtain a better price.
